RESPONSIBILITIES

Community impact initiatives and engagement in local region:

- Project manage and help implement local impact initiatives focused on a key group or issue
- Support Regional Director in community outreach and report internally on local initiatives to Community Impact leadership team
- Support regional agency engagement with information sharing
- Liaise with agencies supported by United Way East Ontario regarding funding agreements, program reporting, etc.
- Engage and support regional Advisory Council volunteers via information sharing and administrative preparations for meetings
- Perform regional resource and contact management and other local office related duties as required

New and ongoing resource development in local region:

- Provide local support to UWEO staff in deploying workplace campaigns
 - Monitor campaign activities and provide accurate information through established reporting mechanisms
 - Attend UWEO and workplace campaign special events and other functions as required
- Work with UWEO staff to manage relationships with local sponsors and donors, including identifying prospective donors

This assignment is a full-time one-year opportunity starting June 1, 2021. This includes professional training. The candidate must be available for the full duration of the placement. Some early morning and evening work may be required.
