PURPOSE OF ASSIGNMENT

The Community Campaign Portfolio Managers provide front-line support to charitable workplace campaigns in organizations across the region, including private companies, universities, colleges, school boards, and municipalities.

As part of a collaborative and dynamic team, you will help with the planning and execution of the United Way community campaign, meeting workplace campaign leads, people in leadership roles, and developing campaign plans to ensure support is raised for our community's most vulnerable.

This work is in support of United Way's impact in our community. As an impact United Way, we work to achieve measurable, lasting change for those who need it most. The Resource Development team brings together campaign leads, donors and partners who provide resources to make a difference. These resources include not only the funds we raise, but also the volunteer efforts we deploy, and the progress we make as we foster greater widespread awareness of our community's toughest challenges.

United Way East Ontario is operating from a hybrid model with two days in office and three days working from home office.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work with United Way staff and Workplace Campaign Leaders to ensure successful campaigns by:
- Meeting campaign volunteers and company leaders.
 - Assisting in the workplace campaign planning process.
 - Delivering training programs for campaign committee members and canvassers.
 - Arranging speaker presentations for campaign events such as for employee group meetings, launch, leadership events, etc.
 - Providing key campaign materials and promotional items.
 - Thanking donors and support efforts to ensure donors know where their gift is having an impact.

- Communicating with Campaign Leaders to monitor campaign activities.
- Providing accurate, up-to-date campaign information through established reporting mechanisms.
- Completing a final assessment and evaluation on each workplace account.
- Attending United Way and workplace campaign special events and other functions, as required.
- Updating key information and data in internal database

ASSIGNMENT DURATION

This assignment is a full-time opportunity for 16 weeks, from August to December 2026. It includes professional training. The candidate must be available for the full duration of the placement.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Interpersonal skills complemented by the ability and desire to build relationships, motivate encourage involvement, and instill a sense of excitement/pride in others.
- Strong organizational and time-management skills to balance multiple priorities; share and promote best practices.
- Excellent teamwork skills for working with a variety of individuals (including senior managers) from diverse backgrounds and ideologies.
- Communication and presentation skills to present ideas, concepts, and strategies to individuals at all organizational levels.
- High-energy level with a flexible approach and willingness “to do whatever it takes to get the job done with integrity”.
- Strong level of comfort with tools such as email, virtual meeting tools, and customer database.
- Bilingualism would be a strong asset.
- Full access to a vehicle and valid driver’s license is preferred.
- Criminal and credit check required
