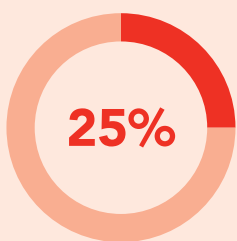

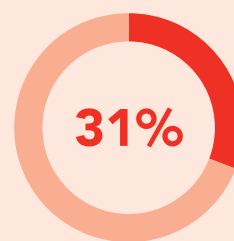
The local facts:*
